


This training document will give you step-by-step instructions on how to print Cognos monthly TAMS statements








- From the results of your search, click the Choose Format icon and select "View in PDF Format" from the dropdown list
- IMPORTANT: You <u>must use the PDF format</u> for the printed version of the report to be properly aligned and formatted

- When the report opens in the PDF format, a grey bar will briefly appear at the bottom of the page with process options
- Choose the Printer icon from the grey bar to open the Print Format dialogue box
 - If the grey bar vanishes, simply hover your mouse near the bottom of the page to make it reappear






Print dialogue box


- Printer: Your computer's default printer should be listed
- Copies: Include the number of copies you would like to print; the default is 1
- Pages to Print: Select All to print all pages of your report; you can also select Current page to print only the page in your current view or Pages to type a range of pages to print





- Under Size Options, accept the default of Actual Size
- IMPORTANT: Under Orientation, change the default of Portrait to Landscape (or to Auto Portrait/Landscape)
 - Notice the Print preview to the right shows part of the report greyed out in the default Portrait orientation





- Now that Landscape is selected as the orientation, notice the print preview to the right is aligned with the entire page in view
- You are now ready to click the Print button to print a formatted version of your report
